

**Subject:-** Extension of time period for export of raw, white/refined sugar under OGL.


The Government has allowed export of 15 lac tons of raw, white/refined sugar under OGL in three tranches of 5 lac tons each vide circular letters dated 19<sup>th</sup> April, 2011, 28<sup>th</sup> June, 2011 and 19<sup>th</sup> August, 2011 respectively. Export release orders have been issued mentioning the condition that only one extension of 30 days will be given on merit. However, some of the exporters have represented the Government to provide for one more extension of 30 days in the validity period of the release order issued for export under OGL on account of logistic constraints faced at the ports.

The Government has considered their request and in order to facilitate export of balance un-exported quota of the sugar mills, it has been decided to consider one more extension of 30 days. All concerned parties may avail this facility to export the balance quantity if it is still lying un-exported due to genuine reasons beyond the control of parties.
